Dear Parents/Carers,

Art Enrichment: Graffiti workshop Thursday 25th June 2026.

As you are aware, your son/daughter has chosen the Art programme of activities for the Enrichment Day. I am writing to confirm your child’s place on this enrichment activity and to inform you about the arrangements along with how to pay. Activities will take place in school time on Thursday 25th June.

School uniform is not required for the activity but please be aware that your son/daughter will be taking part in a graffiti workshop so please do not wear anything that you may not wish to get paint on, however PPE will be provided. Your son/daughter must also adhere to the school’s expectations about suitable non-uniform, as outlined in the letters about non-uniform days. Failure to do this may result in them being unable to participate in the activities for that day. For this day students will have access to the school canteen as normal.

As part of the Enrichment Art Graffiti workshop students will generate word art to create their own ‘tag’ and create a spray paint base layer to work into. Students are expected to uphold the high expectations for behaviour of the school and be aware that they are ambassadors for the school whilst working with visiting graffiti artists.

Thursday 25th June	<p>Students will line up on the playground as normal at 8.40, so an AM register can be taken with their tutor.</p> <p>Come up to AR2 and AR1 after line up.</p> <p><i>Your son/daughter will be split into one of 2 groups.</i></p> <p>Periods 1 – 5 – Rotation of activities including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meeting the Graffiti artists - History of Graffiti Vs Contemporary Street Art - Word generation and creating a personal ‘tag’ - Working with spray paint to practise professional techniques - Adding the tag onto the spray paint

Payment for this activity is £42.50 made payable via Parent Pay, the deadline for payment is Wednesday 3rd June. If your child qualifies for Pupil Premium funding, then the cost of the activity has been covered already.

Please ensure that your emergency contact details are up to date. Students for whom we do not have an up-to-date EV4 form will not be allowed to go on these trips.
