Year 10 Enrichment Day – Thursday 25th June Band 2 STEM Option

As part of our Year 10 Enrichment Day programme, your child will be taking part in an allocated PE enrichment activity during the morning and attending the MIRA MTI Technology Institute during the afternoon.

Students should arrive at school by 8.35am and meet staff on the tennis courts for registration. At 9.10am, students will make their way to the Sports Hall to take part in their allocated PE/sport activity. Students have already been informed of their PE option by their PE teacher.

Students will have an extended break to eat their lunch before the afternoon visit. At 12.10pm, students should return to the tennis courts for registration before departing for the MIRA MTI Technology Institute.
