## Performing Arts Enrichment - 2026

As you are aware, your son/daughter has chosen the Performing Arts, programme of activities for Enrichment Week. I am writing to confirm your child's place on this enrichment activity and to inform you about the arrangements along with how to pay. Activities will take place during the school day on Thursday 25 June.

Payment of £25 is required to take part in the activities and should be made via parent pay by **Wednesday 3 June**. All Pupil Premium students will have their option paid for by the school.

Students will follow the normal timings of the school day and should line up as normal on the playground at 8.40. They will then be taken to their activities for the rest of the day.

School uniform is not required but please ensure that your son/daughter adheres to the School's expectations about suitable non-uniform, as outlined in the letters about non-uniform days. Failure to do this may result in them being unable to participate in the activities for that day. They should ensure they dress comfortably in something appropriate for a dance and drama workshop.

Students will have access to the school canteen as normal. They should bring their normal pencil case and a large bottle of water.

Students are expected to uphold the high expectations for behaviour of the school and be aware that they are ambassadors for the school during any workshops from external visitors. Please note that should students not follow the behaviour expectations, then they may be removed from any of these activities.
