## How do I prepare for my exams?

- Regularly access Google Classroom. Several resources have been placed on there to support you in preparing for your exam. If you miss a lesson check there for the content that was covered and speak to the teacher for any hard copies of resources.
- RAG rate your topic checklists or specification and identify which areas you most need to focus on. If you do not understand some of the content read the relevant textbook chapters and come to a drop in session to go over them.
- Ensure you know A03 evaluation points for all the topics covered. Cue cards may be a useful way of revising these.
- Watch Tutor 2 U videos , make notes on these and then apply this to practice questions. <https://www.tutor2u.net/sociology/reference>
- Access past papers, mark schemes and examiners reports to increase familiarity of what the exam will be like.
- Revisit feedback in your assessment books and improve the questions.
- Use exam technique sheets when answering questions to ensure you know the technique for 4, 6, 10, 20, 30 and 20 MiC questions.
